- **Displayed for each lesson:** Content Objective, Language Objective, Agenda



#### **Curriculum & Planning**

- Weekly Planning Protocol: A framework with guiding questions is used for instructional planning

### **Coaching & Support**

- District C&I Strategist Support: all STAAR course teachers are tiered based on need for support, strategist schedules are planned to maximize teacher need and joint planning
