

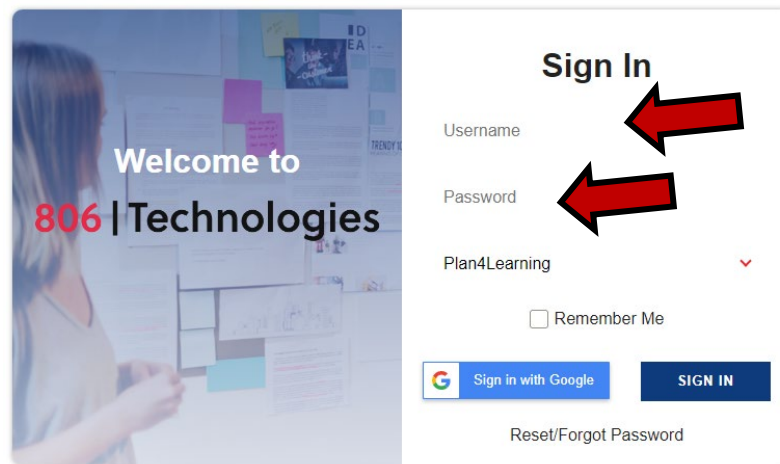
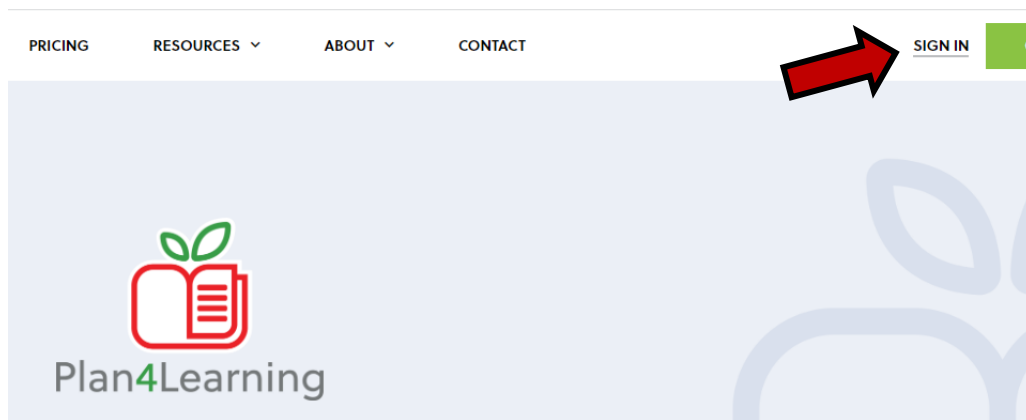

1.1 Create and promote engaging learning opportunities that focus on student needs and high-risk populations so that by August of 2023:

- *3rd grade students that meet or exceed grade level proficiency on STAAR Math will increase from 24% to 28%

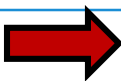



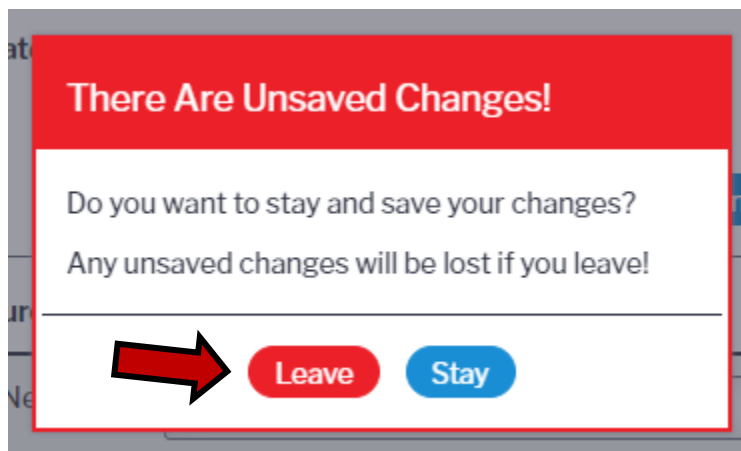
