Instructional Time: 8:00 a.m.-3:40 p.m. Breakfast: 7:30 a.m.-7:55 a.m.

- 1. Being prepared to work and learn.
- 2. Following the school, bus, classroom, and playground rules.
- 3. Respecting the rights of others to learn without distraction and disruption by showing respect for other people and property.
- 4. Cell phones or smart watches must be turned off during the instructional day, unless approved for instructional purposes. Use of a telecommunications device without authorization will be confiscated. A fee of \$15 will be issued when the device is picked up from the principal's office.
- 5. Not using profanity, stealing, or vandalizing **School Property**.
- 6. Completing all assignments and homework to the best of my ability and submitting all assignments on time.
- Spending at least 15-30 minutes at home daily reading to meet my AR goals and to become a better reader.

# AS A PARENT, I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR...

Instructional Time: 8:00 a.m.-3:40 p.m. Breakfast: 7:30 a.m.-7:55 a.m.

- 1. Ensuring my child attends school regularly, arrives on time, and gets picked up on time. (No later than 15 minutes after school dismissal) Providing a courtesy call if I need to change my child's mode of transportation before 2:30pm.
- 2. Supporting the school by following the designated drop-off and pick-up procedures.
- Cell phone use while in the pick-up/drop-off area is prohibited.
- . Morning Drop-off: Remaining on the lane to the right.
- Pick-up Tag is visible at all times. (Reporting to the front office if I do not have a tag)
- 3. Making sure to notify the teacher by class dojo and calling the campus about my child not attending class.
- Submitting a doctor's excuse within 2 days of my child's absence.
- 4. Providing an adequate and **quiet space** so my child can complete homework/read.
- 5. Staying aware of what my child is learning, so I can help them meet his/her responsibilities including homework expectations.
- 6. Scheduling/Attending <u>at least one (1) parent/teacher</u> <u>conference, per six weeks for each of my children.</u>
- 7. Considering volunteering at my child's campus at least once per semester when available. *Examples: Volunteer at the Parent Center, being part of a committee, and student event/decor.*
- 8. Understanding that by participating in parent groups, committees, or parent training workshops, I assert my right to contribute to the decision-making process in my child's school through the CLPAC.
- 9. Assuring that my child and I will read and follow the <u>Donna ISD Student Handbook</u> (Available online on our J.P. LeNoir Website) Receive a copy upon request.

- 11. Updating the school immediately with any changes to parent information. (telephone numbers and/or change of address)

- 13. Ensuring my child does not bring any electronic devices to school.
- 14. Understanding that all electronic devices provided by J.P. LeNoir Elementary to my child are well maintained and be responsible for any damages that may occur due to my child's horse playing/mistreatment of the device.
